



Working in cooperation with Jewish Family Services once again, our participation in Adopt-A-Senior will bring holiday cheer to 250 lonely or financially-challenged seniors in the local area. To stay within the Diocese COVID guidelines, we will have a “drive up” ornament tag distribution before and after all masses on the weekends of 10/31 and 11/7. We will be set up in the parking lot next to the school buses.

JFS has taken into consideration that due to COVID restrictions, many people may still not feel comfortable shopping. With that in mind, this year all tags ask for blankets/afghans and various gift cards. There is no set amount for the gift cards: that is completely up to you. If you would like to purchase items in addition to what is listed on the tag, JFS suggests: hats, gloves, scarves, socks, store bought snacks or anything else you feel would brighten a senior’s holiday season.

Some gift tags just say “Male” or “Female”. This ensures all seniors served by JFS are covered. Please try to include a holiday card to your senior. If you have children, it would really be great if they could make one of their own. Homemade Christmas ornaments would be wonderful!

You will be able to bring the gift bags back to church at “drive through” drop offs before and after masses on the weekends of 11/14, 11/21 and 11/28. We’ll be in the school bus parking area. If you take a tag, PLEASE return the purchased gifts. If you would like to make a monetary donation in lieu of taking a gift tag, we will use that money to make sure that all gift requests are fulfilled. Collection jars will be at the tables.

PLEASE BE SURE TO PLACE UNWRAPPED GIFTS, THE GIFT TAG ORNAMENT AND YOUR CARD INTO A HOLIDAY GIFT BAG BEFORE RETURNING.

All gifts must be returned by 12/1.
